— THE COACHING STAFF —



Coach Lars Tiffany: Coach Tiffany enters his third year at his alma mater where he was a two-time captain and standout defensive player for Brown from 1987-1990. In his second year back at Brown, the Bears went on to win the 2008 Ivy League Championship finishing the season ranked 13th nationally with an 11-3 overall record, 5-1 in the Ivy League. Before returning to Bear country, Tiffany was the head coach at Stony Brook, posting an 18-13 overall mark in his two-year tenure. In 2005-2006 Tiffany led Stony Brook to its first ever Top 20 ranking, climbing as high as #14 in the national polls. The 2005 America East Coach of the Year, Tiffany led Stony Brook to wins over Delaware, Penn State, and Rutgers, as his Seawolves boasted the number-one ranked man-up unit in Division I. Prior to Stony Brook, Tiffany spent four years at Penn State (2000-2004) as the top assistant, where he helped Penn State earn its first ever NCAA tournament bid in 2003.



Coach David Evans: A 1996 graduate of Brown with a B.A. in Political Science, Evans earned a Master's degree in Education from Lesley University in 2006. He is Brown's second all-time leading goal scorer (145), and his 232 career points (145 goals, 87 assists) ranks second in the Brown record book. Evans became the first Brown sophomore to earn first team All-America honors, being selected in 1994. He was a two-time first team All-Ivy and All-New England selection, and team captain for the Bears in 1995 and 1996. Evans also enjoyed a successful professional career, playing for the Boston Cannons. He joined the Cannons in its inaugural season in the MLL, and was a six-time All-Star before retiring in 2006. He won the league's fastest shot contest three years in a row and holds the fastest shot (109 MPH) in the world. He was the Cannon's Most Valuable Player in 2002 and Offensive MVP in 2001. He is also the Cannon's all-time leading goal scorer (133).



Coach Errol Wilson: Coach Wilson is entering his third season at Brown in 2009. Wilson works closely with the goal keepers and in 2008 helped guide Brown's Goalies to the highest save percentage in NCAA Division I. Jordan Burke was named Ivy-League Player of the Year as well as earning Second Team All-America honors. Wilson also assists with the clearing game, man down units, recruiting, and managing game day personnel and substitutions. Wilson played for Coach Tiffany at Stony Brook, graduating in 2006 with a degree in Economics. While at Stony Brook Wilson earned the team's Most Improved Player Award.

Camp Staff: Will include Brown Lacrosse players and alums as well as top coaches and players from some of the best lacrosse programs in the country.

Certified Trainers: Certified athletic trainers will be present at all camp activities.
